# **Swyve Content Moderation Policy**

## **Purpose**

This Content Moderation Policy describes how Swyve reviews, restricts, and removes content that violates our rules, terms of service, or legal obligations. Swyve aims to maintain a safe, lawful, and respectful environment for adult creators and fans.

## 1. Moderation Principles

Our content moderation is guided by the following:

- Legality: No content may violate local, national, or international laws
- Consent: All content must be fully consensual and verifiable
- Safety: No material promoting harm, violence, or exploitation
- Transparency: Users are informed of moderation decisions and have the right to appeal

#### 2. What We Moderate

We review content that is:

- Reported by users or flagged by our moderation team
- Detected by automated tools (e.g., nudity detection, facial age estimation)
- Submitted by unverified or high-risk accounts
- Part of broader investigations (e.g., law enforcement referrals)

#### 3. Prohibited Content Includes

- Child sexual abuse material (CSAM), real or simulated
- Non-consensual sexual activity, hidden cams
- Incest, bestiality, rape content (even fantasy/simulated)
- Sexual violence, blood, torture, or extreme fetish content
- Terrorism, hate speech, or illegal acts
- Unauthorized deepfakes or AI-generated non-consensual content

#### 4. Review Process

All flagged content is reviewed by our human moderators. We consider:

- Context and intent
- Jurisdiction and applicable law

- Creator history and prior violations
- Consent documentation if required

#### 5. Enforcement Actions

Based on severity and frequency, we may:

- Remove or blur violating content
- Issue warnings or temporary suspensions
- Permanently ban accounts or withhold payments
- Report illegal content to authorities

## 6. Appeals

Users may appeal moderation decisions within 30 days. Appeals must include any relevant context or clarification. Our content integrity team will review appeals independently.

# 7. Automation and Human Oversight

Swyve uses machine learning tools to assist moderation but all final decisions are made by trained human reviewers.
