Introduction

Swyve respects the intellectual property rights of others and expects users to do the same. This DMCA Policy explains how copyright owners can notify us of alleged copyright infringement in accordance with the U.S. Digital Millennium Copyright Act (DMCA).

1. Filing a DMCA Notice

If you believe that content on Swyve infringes your copyright, please send a written notice to our Designated Agent containing the following:

- Your name, address, email, and signature (physical or electronic)
- Identification of the copyrighted work claimed to have been infringed
- Identification of the material that is claimed to be infringing and where it is located
- A statement that you have a good faith belief that the use is not authorized
- A statement, under penalty of perjury, that the information in the notice is accurate
- That you are the copyright owner or authorized to act on behalf of the owner

3. Response to DMCA Notices

Upon receipt of a valid DMCA notice, we may:

- Remove or disable access to the allegedly infringing content
- Notify the user who uploaded the content
- Terminate accounts of repeat infringers

4. Submitting a Counter-Notice

If you believe your content was removed in error, you may file a counter-notice including:

- Your name, address, phone number, and signature
- Identification of the removed content and where it appeared
- A statement under penalty of perjury that you have a good faith belief the removal was a mistake

- Your consent to jurisdiction in your local federal court (or any judicial district in which Swyve is located)
- That you will accept service of process from the original complainant

5. Repeat Infringer Policy

Swyve will terminate the accounts of users determined to be repeat copyright infringers, in accordance with our internal procedures and applicable law.

6. Misuse Warning

Knowingly submitting false or fraudulent DMCA notices or counter-notices may result in legal liability. Please only use this process for genuine copyright concerns.
